HUNT VFD NEWS

Hunt and Kerr County community, I would like to open this letter with a thanks to all who have supported the Hunt Volunteer Fire Department over the years. We are constantly researching ways to grow our department to serve and protect our service district, but also to ensure our community has the fire protection they need and deserve. Our membership and board have been working hard to bring the best coverage possible for Hunt, additionally, I have listed some of the items we have on our agenda for 2025 for which we'll need your support.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS THIS YEAR

The Hunt VFD has been diligent in looking for ways to improve our response to calls and keeping our fleet ready for emergencies. We have acquired a drone to assist our department with search and rescue along with scene size-up for wildland scenarios. The drone was purchased with a grant which was awarded to the HVFD solely for the purpose of acquiring a drone and support hardware. We have also added an additional 30,000 gallon rain catchment tank at our Central Station to keep a steady water supply for our emergency vehicles.

MOST RECENT NEWS

We have installed an Artic Air Fill Station to fill our SCBA (Self Contained Breathing Apparatus) bottles to keep our firefighters breathing clean air on calls. Clean air is a top priority when fighting structure fires, car fires, dumpster fires and occasionally, wildland fires. Previously we took our empty bottles to the Kerrville Fire Department and had to schedule multi organizations and personnel to accomplish this task.

HOW YOU CAN HELP US IN 2024

We are in the process of building a new substation on FM 1340 just West of the entrance of Mo Ranch. With all the new developments in Northwestern Hunt, the need for a larger substation with a rain catchment system is a top priority of our department to help support and serve the Hunt community.
